7. Score a success in the first five minutes.
8. Be assertive and take responsibility for the interview.

10. Think positive.
11. Close on a positive note.
12. Bring a copy of your resume to every interview.
13. Make the most of the "Tell me about yourself" question.
14. Be ready for "behavior-based" interviews.
15. Send thank-you notes.
